FIA REQUIREMENTS FOR MINORS

You will need to provide us with specific supporting documentation to FIA verify a minor investor

Required Documentation:


- 1. If the shares are registered in the name of a minor, we require written confirmation from the natural guardian, stating the capacity in which he or she is signing or in the case of a legal guardian, attach a certified copy of the Letters of Guardianship.
- 2. A certified copy of the birth certificate of the minor.
- 3. A certified copy of the identity document of the guardian.
- 4. Signed and stamped letter from your bank on a letterhead confirming your banking details (with your ID number disclosed thereon).

Alternatively, we will accept a certified copy of your bank statement (not an internet bank statement or cancelled cheque) to verify your bank account details.

5. A certified copy of your service bill e.g., rates account, electricity bill or telephone bill bearing your name and current residential address (or erf or stand number and suburb) not older than three months in order to verify your physical address details.

Please note:

- 6. We may not accept third party banking details
- 7. Bank confirmation letter should not be older than 3 months.
- 8. Certified copies must be done by a Commissioner of Oaths.
- 9. Certified copies may not be older than three months
- **10.** If you have been appointed to act on behalf of a shareholder, please supply certified documentation as stated in the power of attorney or mandate of signatories, and certified copy of appointee's ID.
